**II- DETAILED COMPREHENSION**

**A-** **2,5 points (5 x 0,5 point ; 0,5 ou rien)**

- 1) Wrong : "... few people came to visit them." (l.3)
- 2) Wrong: "This (...) was the **one** plane she mustn't miss." (l.9)
- 3) Right: "Mrs Foster didn't care much for the Frenchman..." (ll.14, 15)
- 4) Right: "She knew them only from the many photographs that she had received..." (ll.16, 17)
- 5) Wrong "... he would never consent to leave New York and live in Paris." (ll.24, 25)

  - "... **he would never consent to leave New York** and live in Paris..." (ll.24, 25)
  - "It was a **miracle** that he had ever **agreed** to let her **fly** over there alone for six weeks..." (ll.25, 26)  
*Ne pas accepter "... he insisted on coming to the airport to see her off." (ll.11, 12)*
- 4) "I think **you'll make it all right**." (l.39)
- 5) "It looks a bit **foggy** ..." (l.44)  
*Ne pas accepter "I shouldn't be surprised if the flight's cancelled already." (l.45)*
